In addition to above, NICDC is engaged as Project Management Agency (PMA) by Ministry of Textiles for implementation and monitoring of PM MITRA Parks.

NICDC shall also serve as the nodal agency for implementing the BHAVYA scheme (Bharat Audyogik Vikas Yojna), leading the development of 100 plug-and-play industrial parks across India.

- Provide strategic inputs on industrial compliance systems, environmental infrastructure, cluster governance, and ecosystem management frameworks.
- Engage with State Governments, industrial development agencies, industry associations, industrial park authorities, and private sector stakeholders.

- Identify structural and operational bottlenecks affecting industrial growth, cluster competitiveness, and export performance.
- Support development of institutional models, PPP structures, and ecosystem interventions for industrial cluster development.
